This includes analysing specific markets, investment opportunities and/or existing portfolios, and contributing to decision-making.

The internship will enhance your analysis, problem-solving, presentation, and collaboration skills, as well as give you an overview of the investment process as a part of a highly skilled, non-hierarchical team, making this internship valuable to anyone considering a career in sectors such as private equity, investment management, investment banking, management consulting, real estate, or more.

You will have the opportunity to work in a growing, international company that is challenging the traditional players and investing at scale to create real impact.
